Let's face it, many of us have drawers and wardrobes bulging with clothes, lots of which we probably won't wear again! Also you may be aware of the millions of people around the world who don't even own a pair of shoes, or who don't know where their next meal is coming from. So we want to help you to make a real difference!

Great news - It won't cost you a penny!

At Hope365 we have made it very easy to combine those two issues and dramatically change lives. Better still is the fact that it won't cost you a single penny! Our request is that you would allow us to bring our mobile clothing donation point to your school for a few days and that you would encourage your staff and pupils to bring in unwanted items of clothing. All sorts of clothes, shoes, belts, handbags etc are welcome. **A typical bag of clothes etc for resale equates to 210 school dinners in Ethiopia!** We are even happy to receive torn and worn out items as well as underwear, socks etc which should be labelled as "Rags" and placed in a different bag. Even a typical bag of rags equates to 24 school dinners - so they help too.

What we do in Ethiopia . . .

We rescue kids from the streets and bring them to our Assessment Centre where our professional staff of psychologists, social workers and carers assess their requirements.

Where possible we reunite children with family members. Those who are found to be orphans are welcomed into one of our Group Homes, which replicate as closely as possible a family home, complete with live in house-mums. Our most recent project is the Hope365 Academy which educates up to 400 of the poorest and most vulnerable boys and girls in the region, including reunited Street Kids.
